To assemble: print on both sides, flipping on the short edge, at 100%. Fold one before running more; a misregistered fold wastes the run. Lay the sheet cover-side down. Working left to right: fold the leftmost column over on the first upright line; fold the folded stack under on the middle upright line; fold the top half behind on the long line; fold the remaining column under. The cover faces out. Hold the packet cover-side facing and slit the folded top edge and the folded right-hand edge; the folded left-hand edge is the spine and stays uncut. No staples are needed. A stack cutter finishes a run in one pass per edge. Best on 24lb; crease with the edge of a card.

The Porch Audit Protocol

A field procedure for the inscription of doorstep claims

When presented with the assertion that evidence exists:

1. Acknowledge and welcome. Accept the assertion at face value without judgment. Offer the pen.
2. Categorize. Open the record at page 6 and ask the claimant to select the relevant part: physical, historical, documentary, testimonial, predictive, anomalous, or petitionary.
3. Isolate the claim. Turn to the entry form on page 8. Ask them to state the concrete, physical proposition in one sentence.

Standards of Admissibility

Pursuant to the protocol of this registry, an entry is admissible only if it satisfies three threshold criteria.

I. The Criterion of Independence

The verifying authority cannot be internal to the claim's institutional or devotional tradition. Sacred texts, denominational councils, and personal testimonials from adherents do not constitute independent confirmation.

II. The Criterion of Falsifiability

Every claim must explicitly designate an observable, testable condition that would prove it incorrect. A claim compatible with every possible state of the universe asserts no empirical fact about the universe.
